Award Terms

Coverage for 1-2 years in A*STAR Research Institute (RI)

- Monthly stipend of S\$2,500
- One-time settling-in allowance of \$\$1,000
- One-time airfare grant of S\$1,500
- Conference support
- Medical insurance

Eligibility

- PhD students may participate in this programme if their home university supervisor has a collaboration with an A*STAR researcher
- Open to International students
- Bachelor's degree with at least a Second Class (Upper) Honours or equivalent

The above eligibility criteria are not exhaustive. The A*STAR office may include additional selection criteria based on prevailing scholarship policies. These policies may be amended from time to time without notice.

ARAP Administrative Details & Process

ARAP is a collaboration between A*STAR and overseas universities that provides awards to support PhD graduate students to carry out research attachments at A*STAR research institutes (RIs) and consortia in Singapore.

The Award provides support for living in Singapore, consisting of:

- A monthly stipend of S\$2,500 for the period that the student is based at the A*STAR RI, up to a maximum of 2 years
- A one-time settling-in allowance of S\$1,000
- A one-time airfare grant of S\$1,500

The student should identify a supervisor from his/her university who would collaborate and work with a researcher in one of the A*STAR Research Institutes in order to apply for this Programme.

As students are nominated for ARAP through the A*STAR Research Institutes, A*GA would require the following documents to be submitted to the A*STAR RI Coordinator:

- 1) ARAP (Individual/Partner University) Nomination Form
- 2) PhD Matriculation letter
- 3) Background of how the collaboration was made
- 4) CV
- 5) English Translated Bachelor and Master Transcripts and Certificates
- 6) Copy of Identity Card/Passport
